




Canvas Module Structure 🍟 🗩

Canvas Publish 😽





Course Class Dates

In Canvas, dates for classes are set by the institution by term. Some faculty have classes that don't start on the same dates as most classes (late-start), or might not meet for a full 12 weeks in a typical quarter. You can go in and adjust dates for your class.
