

Zoom Video Deletion

TechConnect Zoom (ConferZoom) has nearly reached the allotted capacity of cloud storage space for the TechConnect Zoom institutional license.

Zoom videos from August 15th, 2020 and earlier will be deleted. This means those videos will be lost forever without possibility of recovery. This handout and video will take you through the steps to preserve any videos you wish to save from this period.

STEP 1

Log on to Zoom (on the Web with Zoom.us). Click on Recordings tab on the Left menu.





STEP 2

Look at the third column over on the top and find the Start Time column that also includes date.





Click on the Zoom recording title in the first column to access the recording.



STEP 5

Download any of the files in the Zoom recording by clicking the arrowed button. The files here will depend on your recording settings.





STEP 6

The files are now on your computer. At this point, you can leave them there, copy to a hard/flash drive, or go to the next steps for public access of the previous Zoom recordings. Note the naming convention of the file (GMT.....)




