Larry has completed the electric charging station (Juice Bar). You can connect your alligator clips inside the holes under the shelf and there are banana plugs, USB's, 110 volt, and cigarette lighter connections inside the box. I had a chance to use it last weekend to charge my 40-volt string trimmer battery. It worked great. The only problem we have not

is that when you close the outside door the master switch is too close and turns back on again. Larry said he will look into this and it should not be a problem if the master switch is left in the ON position.

The charging station combination is the same as the gate.




