★ <u>MEMBERSHIP:</u> The February meeting was called to order by President Larry Woolard on February 18, 7:00 PM at Hobby Town, Virginia Beach, VA. Approximately 21 people were present. This was a rescheduled meeting from the week prior where the meeting had to be cancelled.

### REPORTS

- ★ <u>MINUTES</u> for past meetings were presented in "The Flypaper". A motion to accept them as presented was made and passed.
- ★ TREASURER'S REPORT: Karl reviewed the club's finances. Karl is still due to be audited, TBD.
- ★ FIELD REPORT: No one has been to the field in a while. Please note that if you haven't heard already, there will be loggers removing timber from the wooded area to the right of the access road. Be aware when entering from Ballahack Rd. We do not know the exact dates of the logging but expect it to take place soon. Neither do we know the type or amount of equipment, but were told that the logging company will reimburse us for any damages to the road.

- ★ <u>MODEL OF THE MONTH</u>: No model was brought to the meeting.
- ★ Submit a Formal Comment to the FAA's Proposed Remote ID Rule: On December 26, the FAA released a proposed rule for remote identification of UAS. There are several areas of concern with the proposed rule that AMA will be pushing back on and we need your help advocating for change. We encourage everyone to submit a comment to the FAA's proposed rule for remote ID. The comment period is open until March 2, 2020. AMA has drafted multiple templates that you may use as guidance when forming personal comments. When writing your comment, please identify your own concerns with the proposed rule. It is important to provide a summary of how the proposal will impact your model aircraft operations and include data to back up those concerns. For example, use numbers and address the financial impact the proposal will have on you and suggest alternative solutions.
- ★ Please submit a formal comment to the FAA as soon as possible. To submit a comment, go to the remote ID proposal page on the federal website <u>here</u>. Click on the green "SUBMIT A FORMAL COMMENT" button at the top righthand side of the page. Complete the form and click on the "SUBMIT COMMENT" button at the end. Please note that comments and information provided are public knowledge. Click below to use the drafted templates to express your concerns. You may submit more than one comment.

## FAA NPRM | HOW TO COMMENT

### Making your voice heard is easy.

- » Visit **www.regulations.gov** and type FAA-2019-1100 in the search box.
- » Click on the Comment Now! button.
- » Identify your concerns within the proposed Remote ID rule.
- » Provide a summary of how your concerns will impact model aircraft operations.
- » Include data to back up your concerns when possible.
- » Provide alternative solutions.
- » Address financial impacts affecting you, your club, and the hobby industry.
- » Use templates on www.modelaircraft.org/gov to get started with your own personalized comment.
- » Submit comments by March 2, 2020.
- » Contact AMA for assistance.

### More about the proposed rule:

In December 2019, the FAA released a proposed rule for Remote ID on UAS. The rule can be read in its entirety at www.regulations.gov by searching for FAA-2019-1100. The proposal is deeply flawed; some of the main concerns include the exclusion of a path for community-based organizations (CBOs), such as AMA, to establish and maintain fixed flying sites that satisfy Remote ID compliance. Second, the rule does not create a pathway for Remote ID compliance at AMA events and competitions. Third, the rule should account for situations where there is no internet connectivity, as many safe places to fly are in rural areas with little or no service. Finally, the rule should not require modelers to register each of their aircraft individually.


