DEFINITIONS

STOP. Fur Classification. You may not sell any animal skin or part thereof with hair or fur fibres attached thereto, either in its raw or processed state or the pelt of any animal killed for the animal's fur. 'Animal' including, but not limited to mink, fox, rabbit, karakul lamb and raccoon dog is prohibited.

GO. "Fur" classification. The following items are permitted to be sold:

- 1) Such skins as are, or are to be, converted into leather or which in processing have, or shall have, the hair, fleece, or fur fibre completely removed. May be sold.
- 2) Materials clipped, shorn, or combed from animals, fleece, sheepskin etc. May be sold.
- 3) Leather or hair attached to skin that is typically used as leather e.g. cowhide with hair attached. May be sold.
- 4) Synthetic materials intended to look like fur (faux fur) may be sold.
