STOP. Fur Classification. You may not sell any animal skin or part thereof with hair or fur fibres attached thereto, either in its raw or processed state or the pelt of any animal. 'Animal' including, but not limited to mink, fox, rabbit, sheep, karakul lamb and raccoon dog is prohibited.

GO. "Fur" classification. The following items are permitted to be sold:

- 1) Skin as a bi-product of the food chain, converted into leather or which in processing has, or shall have, the hair, fleece, or fur fibre completely removed e.g. leather shoes and handbags. May be sold.
- 2) Synthetic materials intended to look like fur (faux fur) may be sold.
