
# **Remi Adeleke**

#### **About Remi Adeleke:**


Remi was born into riches in Nigeria, but following the death of his father and the unjust seizing of his family's wealth by the Nigerian Government, Remi, his mother, and brother permanently relocated to the Bronx, New York in 1987. After years of making regrettable decisions, Remi enlisted in the Navy in 2002, serving as a corpsman with 1<sup>st</sup> Marine Division and later joined the Navy SEALs where he specialized in combat medicine and HUMINT (Human Intelligence/tradecraft). Ending his successful naval career in 2016, he was led to pursue opportunities in film/tv consulting, directing, writing, and acting, including the 2017 franchise film


Transformers: The Last Knight, SEAL Team CBS, the Universal thriller directed by Michael Bay, Ambulance, and the Lionsgate blockbuster The Plane. As a script and production consultant Remi worked on the said mentioned, along with Netflix's 6 Underground, Apple+ TV series Invasion, Here Comes The Flood, and In The Likely Event for Netflix and Dylan Clark Productions. Remi is the host and Co-EP of the *Down Range* narrative Podcast for Tenderfoot TV/iHeart Media. Additionally, Remi was one of the hosts of the UK hit series, Who Dares Wins and its U.S. derivative Special Forces: World's Toughest Test, as well as the sole host for Omaha Productions/History's **Beyond The Battlefield**. As a filmmaker, Remi wrote and directed *The Unexpected*, which is a 32-minute short film that uncovers an international organ harvesting ring. In addition to the short, he has written and will be directing the feature length version, titled, Unexpected Redemption for G-Base and Loose Cannon Pictures. Remi wrote and directed a long form commercial for his thriller novel debut, Chameleon: A Black Box Thriller, which published July 25<sup>th</sup> 2023, as well as its acclaimed **Short Film** of the same name. Remi produced the documentary *Hero*, alongside multi-Emmy winner Nick Nanton. As a WGA screenwriter Remi co-penned the adapted teleplay for *Slave Stealers*, which highlights abolitionist, Harriet Jacobs. He also wrote *The Chameleon* feature screenplay, which was optioned and redeveloped by Flynn Pictures and the entire first season of the TV series (adaptation of Chameleon book 1). and finally The Last Shall Be First screenplay, which tells the untold true story of the first group of African Americans to serve in U.S. Special Forces and the integral but forgotten role they played in the retaking of South Korea from Communist forces. Remi's most recent screenplay is an animation adaption of his upcoming children's book *Eleni & The Minotaur's Maze*. Mr. Adeleke holds a bachelors in organizational leadership and a masters in organizational strategy, both from the University of Charleston West Virginia. Remi's incredible story can be found in his HarperCollins bestselling autobiography, Transformed: A Navy SEALs Unlikely Journey From The Throne Of Africa, To The Streets Of The Bronx, To Defying All Odds, which has also been adapted for screen by Remi Adeleke.
