Why is TNR more effective than simply removing cats?

- **Territorial behavior:**

Feral cats are highly territorial, so when a sterilized cat is returned to their area, they actively defend their territory against newcomers, preventing new cats from establishing themselves.

- **Population control:**

By preventing reproduction, TNR directly addresses the root cause of population growth, leading to a gradual decline in the overall cat population within a colony.

- **No replacement cycle:**

Removing cats creates an open space that is quickly filled by new cats drawn to the available food and shelter, leading to a continuous cycle of removal and replacement.

- **Humane approach:**

TNR is considered a more humane method compared to removing cats, as it allows existing feral cats to live out their lives in their familiar environment.
