Lunch/Snack: Students bring packed lunches. We will have a Spaghetti fund-raiser once or twice per month. Parents sign up to bring snack ingredients for 1 to 2 weeks per year. We encourage whole grains, fresh fruits and vegetables and non-processed foods. Healthy fuel is vital for learning.

Nap: We ask that parents bring in a 2 inch mat (available at Walmart). A standard crib sheet and blanket fit the mats well. Pillows and a special stuffed animal are also nice for your child to rest with. Children ages 4.5 and up have the option to stay up for the 2nd work cycle.

Specials: Our Kindergarten and Elementary students get the opportunity to have additional large on-going art projects throughout the year. They are taught by Kay Mattingly,. She has taught art in many local Montessori schools. Clifford Koufmon will continue our African Drumming lessons. Amber Jennings is certified in Group Fitness and Zumba. She enjoys exercising with the children on days when we can not go outside due to weather limitations. Lauren D'Amato teaches music classes in recorder to our elementary students. She also offers lessons in voice, piano and band instruments once a week for an additional fee.
