**Lunch/Snack:** Students bring packed lunches. We will have a Spaghetti fund-raiser weekly on Fridays. Parents pay an annual snack fee corresponding to the amount of days their child is enrolled. We have a morning snack available during work cycle as well as an afternoon snack for children in aftercare. We also have food preparation lessons available throughout the morning work cycle.

**Nap:** We ask that parents bring in a 2 inch mat (available at Walmart). A standard crib sheet and blanket fit the mats well. Pillows and a special stuffed animal are also nice for your child to rest with. Children ages 4.5 and up have the option to stay up for the 2nd work cycle.

**Specials:** Our Kindergarten and Elementary students get the opportunity to have additional large on-going art projects throughout the year. They are taught by Kay Mattingly,. She has taught art in many local Montessori schools. Jodi Marr teaches Spanish to the Primary and Elementary children on Wednesdays. Clifford Koufmon will continue our African Drumming lessons. Amber Jennings is certified in Group Fitness and Zumba. She enjoys exercising with the children on days when we can not go outside due to weather limitations. Lauren D'Amato teaches music classes in recorder to our elementary students. She also offers lessons in voice, piano and band instruments once a week for an additional fee.
