**Lunch/Snack:** Students bring packed lunches. We may have a Pasta fund-raiser weekly on Fridays pending COVID resolution. Parents pay an annual snack fee corresponding to the amount of days their child is enrolled. We have a morning snack available during work cycle as well as an afternoon snack for children in aftercare. We may have food preparation lessons available throughout the morning work cycle.

**Nap:** We ask that parents bring in a 2 inch mat (available at Walmart). A standard crib sheet and blanket fit the mats well. Pillows and a special stuffed animal are also nice for your child to rest with. Children ages 4.5 and up have the option to stay up for the 2nd work cycle.

**Specials:** Our Kindergarten and Elementary students get the opportunity to have additional large on-going art projects throughout the year. They are taught by Hannah Rowell,. She has taught art in many local community centers and colleges for many years. Jodi Marr is excited to come back to teach Spanish. Lauren D'Amato teaches music classes in recorder and chorus to our elementary students. She also offers lessons in voice, piano and band instruments once a week for an additional fee.
