RECIPE OF THE MONTH

3 to 4 boneless skinless chicken breasts
1 (10.5-oz) can Unsalted Cream of Chicken Soup
2 (0.87-oz) envelopes of chicken gravy mix
1/2 cup water or low sodium chicken broth

Hot steamed rice or mashed potatoes

1. Place chicken in the slow cooker and season with salt and pepper, if desired.
2. Whisk together soup, gravy mix, and water or broth. Pour over chicken.
3. Cover crock-pot and cook on LOW for 4-6 hours.
4. Before serving break the chicken breasts into bite-sized pieces. Serve over hot steamed rice or mashed potatoes.

- Can add frozen vegetables to the mixture
- Do NOT make the gravy. You are only using the dry mix.
- Can use chicken thighs or tenderloins in place of chicken breasts.
