#### **RECIPE OF THE MONTH:**

**Lasagna roll ups (freezable)**

**We will be making this**

**December 17<sup>th</sup> at 1:00 sign-up sheet posted**

One package of lasagna noodles  
 15 oz part-skim ricotta cheese  
 16 oz cottage cheese, small curd  
 8 ounces shredded mozzarella cheese  
 1 cup grated Parmesan cheese, divided  $\frac{3}{4}$  and  $\frac{1}{2}$   
 2 large eggs  
 2-3 tbsp Italian seasoning (to taste)

Cook noodles about 3 minutes less than package says, drain rinse with cold water and set aside.

While that is cooking, combine the above ingredients, less the  $\frac{1}{2}$  cup parm and place in fridge until noodles are done.

On parchment paper, lay out one noodle and place a row of cheese mixture down the center. Leaving about 1 inch at the end of the noodle. Starting at one end, roll up noodle, place on parchment lined baking sheet. Repeat until noodles or filling is gone. If you have left over cheese mixture, this can be frozen and used later.

Flash freeze the roll ups that you have for about 10-15 minutes. Using a seal-a-meal, or freezer bagging, place your desired amount of roll ups in and then seal.

These can freeze for over a year, if sealed properly.

When ready to bake, you can use plain sauce or sauce with meat. Preheat oven to 425 degrees. It will be the same with a toaster oven.

Place a small portion of sauce in the bottom of a baking pan (8x8 or larger) then place the desired amount of frozen roll ups in the dish. Cover down the center of the roll ups with sauce to your liking. Cover with foil and bake for 25 minutes. Uncover and top with Parm or Mozzarella cheese and bake until cheese is melted or blended.
