RECIPE OF THE MONTH

Easy Ham & Cheese Quiche (This is one that we made for Mother's Day)

- 1 refrigerated pie crust
- □ 6 large eggs
- 34 cup milk or cream
- □ ¾ teaspoon salt
- □ ¼ teaspoon black pepper
- 🗆 1 cup cooked ham chopped
- 🔲 1½ cups shredded cheese divided
- 🗆 3 tablespoons green onions
- 1. Preheat oven to 375°F.
- 2. Unroll pie crust and press into a 9" pie plate, crimping the top edges if desired.
- 3. In a large bowl, whisk together eggs, milk, salt and pepper.
- 4. cheese Sprinkle ham, 1 cup of, and green onions into the pie crust and pour the egg mixture over top. Sprinkle remaining ½ cup cheese on top of egg mixture.
- 5. Bake for 35-40 minutes until the center is completely set. Let cool for 5-10 minutes before slicing and serving.
