RECIPE OF THE MONTH

Best Coleslaw Recipe (this is the recipe that has been served at the summer events): Serves 6

3 cups Green Cabbage (finely chopped)
2 cups Purple Cabbage (finely chopped).
1 cup slivered carrots

You can also buy a bag of pre chopped slaw

Dressing:

½ cup mayonnaise/dressing
1 tablespoon white vinegar
½ tablespoon cider vinegar
2 teaspoons sugar
½ teaspoon celery seeds
salt & pepper to taste

(optional) raisins

Combine the dressing ingredients in a bowl and set aside. Chop all the cabbage and carrots (or open the bag) and combine that in a bowl. Drizzle the dressing over the top of the slaw and combine. If it looks to saucy, it's ok, the slaw will soak it up. Refrigerate at least 1 hour. Stir again before serving
