PASTA HOUSE SALAD: SHARON SMITH

head iceberg lettuce
head romaine lettuce
large red onion
oz jar pimentos (drained)
10 oz can artichoke hearts
10 oz can hearts of palm
Shredded provolone cheese

Dressing: ¹⁄₂ cup oil 1/3 cup vinegar ¹⁄₂ cup parmesan cheese salt & pepper to your liking.

Chop lettuce, onion, artichokes, and palm. Throw everything into a bowl and combine.
