Recipe of the Month Easy Slow Cooker Pork Chops

6 boneless pork chops (thick cut) 2 cans cream of chicken soup (10 oz each) 2 Tbsp ranch seasoning mix 1/2 cup chicken broth

Place pork chops in a crock pot.

In a mixing bowl, whisk together the cream of chicken soup, ranch seasoning mix and chicken broth.

Pour this mixture on top of the pork chops in a crock pot.

Cover and cook on low for 5-7 hours or on high for 2.5-3.5 hours until the pork has an internal temperature of 165 degrees F.

Serve over your favorite sides and enjoy!
