Recipe of the Month



Baked Chicken Chimichangas

8oz pkg. cream cheese 8oz. Pepperjack cheese, shredded 1 1/2 Tbsp. taco seasoning 1 lb. cooked chicken, shredded 8 flour tortillas cooking spray shredded cheddar cheese

For garnish:

green onions, sour cream, salsa & guacamole

Stir together cream cheese, Pepperjack cheese and taco seasoning.

Fold in chicken.

Divide among flour tortillas.

Tuck in sides and roll up each tortilla.

Lay seam side down in a sprayed 9x13" baking dish.

Spray tops of tortillas with cooking spray.

Bake at 350 for 15 minutes.

Turn Chimi's over, bake an additional 10 minutes, sprinkle shredded cheddar on top of Chimi's and cook for 5 more minutes.

Garnish with green onions, sour cream, and salsa.
