Recipe of the Month

The Best Meatloaf (used for the Monthly Dinner)

2 lbs ground beef, 85% or 80% lean*
1 tbsp minced onion
1 tsp <u>olive oil</u>
2 large eggs
3 garlic cloves, minced
2 Tbsp ketchup
3 Tbsp fresh parsley, finely chopped
3/4 cup Panko breadcrumbs, or gluten-free bread crumbs
1/3 cup milk

1 tsp <u>salt</u>, or to taste

2 tsp Italian seasoning1/2 tsp ground black pepper

In a large bowl, add all the meatloaf ingredients and mix just until combined (your hands are your best tool for mixing – put on disposable gloves if you want to). Be careful not to over mix. If you do, then the hamburger will be tough.

Add meat to a loaf pan and shape it into a meatloaf. Bake uncovered at 350°F for 60 minutes or until internal temperature is 160 degrees. Let rest about 10 minutes and serve.
