Thanks to a 1-million-dollar donation from Robert "Bob" DeVore, the ILEF proudly announces the transformation of Vocational Grants to Career/Technical/Professional (CTP) grants. Bob's generous gift reminds us that local kids can accomplish big things. Bob was that "local kid" who grew up in Indian River; he did not forget where he came from and wanted to give back. Although there's still much work ahead and more funding needed, this generous donation will allow the ILEF to have an even greater impact facilitating trade careers for Inland Lakes graduates.

The first Vocational Grant was awarded in 1987 to Randy Bunker for \$1.000 toward Automotive Mechanic certification. Under the evolved CTP offering, grant recipients will pursue an even greater variety of specialized training for professional certification and/ or licensing in the skilled trade industry. CTP grant expansion was driven by the ever-changing educational landscape and the Foundation's continued commitment to enhance educational opportunities for Inland Lakes graduates. These grants add an even broader dimension of funding opportunities for past and present Inland Lakes graduates. Primary and Continuing Education scholarships round out the financial offerings available for post-secondary education.

How is the Foundation Financed?

The foundation depends upon contributions such as memorial gifts, wills, trusts, and other means from individuals, organizations and businesses to support its activities. Because the ILEF is a 501(c)3 non-profit organization, contributions are deductible under the Internal Revenue code.

To ensure a permanent source of funding, contributions are placed in an endowment fund. The interest and dividends paid on this fund is used for the scholarships awarded each year. As the endowment fund increases so does the number and size of scholarships.

To date the ILEF has awarded more than 901 scholarships in excess of \$1.976,394 dollars to Inland Lakes graduates. In keeping with the ever-changing educational landscape, we have broadened funding to include Career/ Technical/Professional (CTP) Trade grants as well as primary and continuing scholarships.
