The buyer acquires the right of ownership of kitten and the breeder sells the kitten:

Breeder transfers the animal to buyer with the following documents completed:

The buyer is regarded as the full-fledged owner of the kitten and bears full responsibility for the emotional and physical needs of the kitten from the moment the kitten is received. The buyer is responsible for seeing that the animal receives routine veterinary care. The seller is not responsible for veterinary costs after the buyer acquires the animal. The buyer at their own expense has the right to check the health of the animal in a licensed veterinary establishment within 72 hours after receiving the animal. If there is an untreatable health condition, the buyer has the right to return the animal. All return transportation costs are funded entirely by the buyer. The breeder accepts the return of the animal and reimburses the buyer the full cost of the animal. For a refund, the animal must be returned within seven days from the date the buyer received the animal and be accompanied by a veterinary certificate confirming the untreatable condition or congenital malformation. The seller is not liable for hidden defects, future health issues and shortcomings which cannot be determined after the 72 hour warranty. A full refund of money after the 72 hour warranty given by the breeder is excluded. If it is determined by a veterinarian that the kitten has died due to a congenital malformation in the first year of life, please contact breeder as a new kitten or partial refund may be offered. The buyer assumes the risk of owning a kitten. The total liability of the breeder shall not exceed the purchase price. The breeder does not give any guarantees of the exhibition career, weight, or the reproductive qualities of the animal. If the animal is sold without breeding rights, it is forbidden to pair the animal with any cats and the buyer undertakes to spay/neuter the animal within six months from the date of transfer. If the buyer does not pick up or arrange transportation of the kitten before _____ the breeder reserves the right to terminate this contract; in this case, the deposit is non-refundable. The deposit is refundable if the breeder is unable to produce the kitten by the above date. The agreement between the seller and the buyer is certified by signatures below:
