ELIGIBILITY

This program is designed to provide monies for any fine art program in the Brunswick County Schools to augment and enhance the current existing program. ANY teacher in ANY of the fine arts programs in Brunswick County, NC schools may apply for these funds. If collaboration is planned (i.e. music and visual art), each teacher may submit a request, or a combined request may be submitted for both areas of concentration. Grant amounts are customarily in the amount of approximately \$750.00

Payment will be disbursed directly to the school, who in turn will pay for the supplies that are ordered. Monies **must** be used by February 1 of the year following the award, and on the specific project to which the monies were awarded. **If the project is not implemented, the grant funds must be returned to Stepping Up For Arts.**

All school grant winners and their students consent to have their photos taken and their names used for publicity purposes in support of [Stepping Up For Arts](#).

Teachers and students may be invited to speak at our fundraising events, if they are available at that time.

All school grant winners **must** provide photos of the results of their project along with a soundbite concerning its success. This will be used for further fundraising efforts.

The Selection Committee would welcome the opportunity to visit the schools to see first hand the results of your labors.
