



## CDL Starter Packet

Minimum Requirements to Get Started on Your CDL

### Eligibility

- Must be 18 years old for intrastate (within Florida) or 21 for interstate/hazmat.
- Hold a valid driver's license.
- Proof of U.S. citizenship or lawful presence.

### Required Documents

- ✓ Valid Driver's License
- ✓ Social Security Card
- ✓ Proof of Residency
- ✓ Birth Certificate or Passport

### DOT Medical Card

- Pass a DOT Physical Exam with a certified examiner.
- Receive a Medical Examiner's Certificate (valid up to 24 months).
- Submit to DMV to keep CDL medical status active.

### CDL Permit (CLP)

- Apply at DMV and pass knowledge tests:
  - General Knowledge
  - Air Brakes (if applicable)
  - Combination Vehicles (for Class A)
- Permit valid 180 days.

### Entry-Level Driver Training (ELDT)

- FMCSA requires ELDT theory and behind-the-wheel training before skills test.
- Gorgeous TruckHers provides FMCSA-approved ELDT Theory Training ■.

### CDL Skills Test

- After training, schedule your CDL Skills Test:
  - Pre-Trip Inspection
  - Basic Control Skills
  - Road Test

- Conducted by a certified State Examiner.
