2023-2024 SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION



Description: DABC Scholarships are awarded each year to the senior athletes who show the most initiative, dedication, commitment, and team spirit. The recipients are recognized as those teammates whom the team could count on to give their best effort at practice, pitch in to help with team needs, and encourage fellow teammates to excel.

Eligibility:

- 1. Applicant must be a high school senior, graduating during the academic school semester in which the scholarship is awarded.
- 2. Applicant or their family must be a current member in good standing of the Dawson Aquatic Booster Club (booster fees paid by March 1st, 2024) **or** submit an application fee of \$75.00.
- 3. Applicant must be a member in good standing of Dawson Aquatics Program i.e. Attendance at practices and meets, Conduct, Fundraising, etc.
- 4. Applicant must have participated and completed at least three years with the Dawson High School Aquatics Program including their senior season. Transfer students may satisfy this requirement with competitive aquatic seasons at their previous high school.
- 5. Applicant must have a GPA of 3.5 or higher on a 6.0 scale.
- 6. Applicant or their family must have officially volunteered at least three times during the 2023/24 swim and/or the 2023 water polo season. Holding a DABC Officer or Chair position will satisfy this requirement.
- 7. Applicant must have applied to or been accepted at a post high-school education program for the 2024-2025 academic year.
- 8. Applicant must abide by the Pearland ISD and Dawson Aquatics Codes of Conduct. Violation of these Codes of Conduct will disqualify an applicant from consideration.

Notes:

- Money will be distributed to the recipient in the Fall 2024 semester upon proof of school acceptance and registration.
- DABC reserves the right to determine the number and dollar amount of scholarships available each year based on the financial standing of the Club.
- A point system (outlined in this packet) is used to determine the recipient(s). Final decision on scholarship recipients is subject to the discretion of DABC.
