COACHES CODE OF CONDUCT

I hereby pledge during the BSB Season to follow this Code of Conduct:

- ❖ I will never place the value of winning before the safety and welfare of the players.
- ❖ I will always show respect for players, other coaches, directors and officials.
- ❖ I will lead by example, demonstrating fair play and sportsmanship at all times.
- I will demonstrate knowledge of the rules of the game, and teach these rules to my players.
- I will never use inappropriate language in an abusive manner to players, spectators, officials or directors.
- ❖ I will not tolerate inappropriate behavior, regardless of the situation.
- ❖ I will not allow the use of drugs, tobacco or alcohol by any players.
- ❖ I will motivate players to produce their best effort, inspiring players to learn and encouraging players to be winners.
- ❖ I will refrain from any activity or conduct that may be detrimental or reflect adversely on BSB or it's directors.
- ❖ I will make all efforts to show disciplinary action for players, parents and spectators who are using profane gestures, profanity, arguing or displaying disruptive behaviors.

The BSB Travel Program has instituted a Zero Tolerance Policy. This is created to encourage a positive environment for all players, coaches, umpires and spectators.

The rule states: "Directors, Coaches, Players, Family Members and Spectators that demonstrate behavior that is detrimental to the program may be removed from the BSB Program." Detrimental behavior is defined as "physical and/or verbal abuse towards any participant, coach, director or official at any time." Vulgar language, physical abuse or gestures WILL NOT BE TOLERATED. Violators of this Zero Tolerance Policy during BSB functions will be ejected and may be subject to game, practice or season removal.
