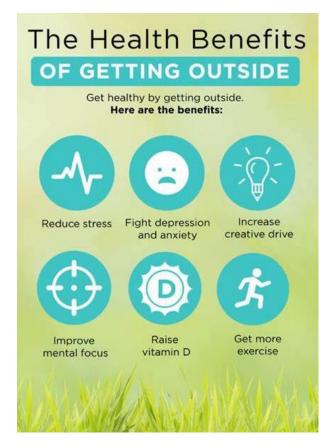


BTGM Parent/Carer Questionnaire
