



USEFUL INFORMATION BEFORE BOOKING OUR TOURS

Children policy for regular half-day and full-day tours:

For applicable reductions or conditions please check the brochure.

Pick-up time from centrally-located hotels:

Our pick-up service takes place in the centre of Rome. Depending on traffic conditions and on the number of passengers who booked that specific tour, it takes around one hour for the bus to pick up all of the passengers. For this reason, pick-up times are shown as an interval. "Starting from 7:30" means that in order to be on time for the beginning of the tour, we will pick up you from your hotel at 7:30 or later.

Dress code and clothing restrictions:

In Rome, especially in places of worship and inside the Vatican Museums, it is strictly forbidden to bring strollers, bulky bags and umbrellas.

Above-the-knee skirts and pants, low-cut clothing and sleeveless tops are never allowed in places of worship and inside the Vatican. Guests who fail to respect the attire requirements may be turned down at the entrance of the point of interest, therefore we suggest wearing or bringing appropriate clothes before the beginning of the tour.

Important notes:

If you have a metal-coated pacemaker, you have to show your pacemaker identification card at the security checks.

Designed by Michelangelo in 1547, St. Peter's dome was finished by Giacomo della Porta and Domenico Fontana in 1590.

It's the highest dome in the world, measuring 136.57 metres (448.1 ft) from the floor to the top of the external cross.

Borghese Gallery: An important museum in the heart of Rome

When in Rome, one cannot miss out on the Borghese Gallery, a museum that houses a very important art collection including works by Bernini, Caravaggio, Canova and Raphael. A professional local guide will illustrate the Gallery and its elegant, sophisticated and even regal interior and exterior spaces. The underlying sculptures and paintings in the building come from the private collection of cardinal Scipione Borghese (1579 - 1633), an art collector and patron, son of Ortensia Borghese, pope Paul V's sister. The cardinal's attention was directed to all Renaissance and contemporary art expressions, but wasn't really into medieval art. Thus, his ambitions favored sculptures and marble groups whose high standards rivalled those of ancient art. Pauline Bonaparte as Venus Victrix, sculpted by Canova between 1805 and 1808, has been here since 1838. In 1807 Camillo Borghese gave Napoleon 154 statues, 160 busts, 170 bas reliefs, 30 columns and a number of other objects that now make for a Borghese-derived Louvre catalog. Bernini's artworks (Apollo and Daphne, The rape of Proserpina, David, to name just a few) have a prominent position in the gallery's spaces on the first floor, too - so much so that one cannot but remain literally entranced by them. The collection of paintings is also very compelling: Pictures by Caravaggio, Titian, Correggio and Raphael are displayed on the second floor among many others. Tickets to the Gallery must be booked well in advance, but we take care of it! By booking this tour, access is secured and you won't have to pay anything at check-in. The tour starts at the Meeting point K which each guest will reach on their own. As an upgrade, one can opt for the version with pick-up from centrally located hotels to reach the museum with us stress-free by minivan. When the tour is over, we suggest lingering outside in Villa Borghese, the huge public garden where the Gallery is located. Everyone finds a walk along the villa's tree-flanked promenades very relaxing. The Pincio terrace is a twenty-minute walk, this being one of Rome's hills. From here one can enjoy wonderful views not only over Piazza del Popolo right below and the Prati district, but also St Peter's Dome, the Gianicolo, the Quirinale, Piazza Venezia as well as the Capitol hill. The outlook from the Pincio is really one of a kind!

Ancient Basilicas and underground Catacombs

Rome's churches are among the most beautiful and ancient in the Western world: spend an afternoon discovering some of them on this guided tour. Despite several additional construction projects and damages, the basilica retains the core of its original 442 AD structure. Even more ancient, Saint John Lateran Basilica: the oldest public church in Rome as well as the highest-ranked papal major basilica. It stands over the remains of a military Roman imperial fort established in AD 193 that was later converted into a place of worship and suffered several damages due to earthquakes and fires: the stunning façade as it appears today was completed in 1.735. In the nearby, the Scala Sancta (the Holy Stairs): white marble steps encased in wooden ones. According to Catholic tradition, they formed the staircase leading up to the praetorium of Pontius Pilate in Jerusalem on which Jesus stepped during his Passion. And talking ancient, the Catacombs of St. Callixtus deserve a visit: these underground burial places, outside the walls of the city, were carved through tuff, a soft volcanic rock. More than fifty martyrs and early Popes were buried in this huge graveyard.

The Legends of Rome: Walking tour of the Velabrum

The Velabro tour is a journey through time that starts from about 3000 years ago and unravels years of history up until the last century, visiting the places and stories that marked the creation of Rome together with monuments and legends that still remain unknown to most people. A small part of the city that hides an amazing concentration of beauty, history and myth, lived in the shadow of the renowned Bocca della Verità for many years. We will discover many local traditions, as well as some sayings that are still used today; formulas for good luck that the more daring can even try to invoke to tempt fate. Churches, arches and ancient temples await us to reveal their precious stories and timeless secrets. Starting from Piazza Bocca della Verità, we will begin our journey from the legendary mask, which was once a wellhead, and discover together why it is still feared so much today. We will continue to discover the great four-sided arch known as the Arch of Janus, which will introduce us to the thousandyear-old church of San Giorgio in Velabro, next to which the highly decorated Arch of the Argentari will reveal its mysteries. We will walk along Via di San Giovanni Decollato and its church, until we reach Piazza della Consolazione, where the Tarpeian Rock awaits. Our tour will continue to the sacred area of S.Omobono (where we will discover a particularly used but vulgar saying!), then we will move on to the Church of San Nicola in Carcere, whose structure is imprisoned among the ruins of three different Roman temples. Here, our tour will end where it also began, closing the circle in Piazza Bocca della Verità, to observe the Foro Olitorio and the Foro Boario, with their temples incredibly well preserved until today.

The Jewish Ghetto of Rome

When you think of Rome's history and its great empire, you can't help but think that this wonderful city is the epitome of history itself. But Rome is great and generous even within itself. Of the old homes where thousands of Jews were isolated for centuries, almost nothing remains today. However, as you walk through the alleys of the ghetto, full of monuments, buildings, streets and in the eyes of some of the descendants of those who lived here in the past, you will find that inheritance still lives within them today. Visit one of Rome's most fascinating neighbourhoods with us and discover the history of one of the oldest **Jewish** communities in the world. Walk with our guide through the alleys of the Ghetto and discover traces of Imperial Rome such as the Theatre of Marcellus or Portico of Octavia. We will retrace the history of the Jewish people in the city of Rome, from ancient to modern times, without ever forgetting the victims of the Holocaust, of which the "stumbling stones" (concrete cubes bearing a brass plate) fixed into the floor are a tangible testimony. You will also have the chance to discover the typical recipes of traditional Jewish-Roman cuisine, such as delicious artichokes "alla giudia", or the tart with ricotta cheese and sour cherries. During this wonderful walk you will admire the 19th century synagogue and end your visit with the sound of the water of the Renaissance turtle fountain in Piazza Mattei.

Rome's Ghosts and Mysteries

The ghosts and mysteries hidden in a city like Rome have perhaps always scared us a little, right? The Eternal City is famous for its thousand-year history made of battles, conquests, intrigues and mysteries, of great heroes and restless souls who do not want to leave the scene to the passage of time. And so you think they move through the alleys, bridges and squares of this mysterious and sometimes ghostly city of ours. Our adventure starts from Castel Sant'Angelo, which we will only see from the outside. This place is known for its prisons where nobles, artists and common criminals lived. Once we leave the Castle, we will continue along Via del Governo Vecchio to reach Piazza Pasquino. There, we will find the statue of an ancient Greek hero, or what remains of it: a bust and a "swollen" face. Leaving the statue, we then reach **Piazza Navona**. Restless souls also hover over the next stop, the **Pantheon**, a masterpiece of Roman engineering, first a pagan temple and then a Catholic church. We will finally arrive in Piazza della Minerva. At its center since 1667, we can admire the obelisk of the Minerva placed on the back of a small elephant known as "The little elephant of the Minerva". A little further away we will find Largo di Torre Argentina, where the great Julius Caesar was assassinated; one of the most eclectic and important figures of the Roman Empire, who still brings many mysteries with him. We will end our tour in Piazza Mattei, which takes its name from the palace of Giacomo Mattei that overlooks it.







Take your authentic Roman-style pasta cooking class in the Jewish district of Rome as seen in the Stanley Tucci's show. Take a break from visiting the city by meeting local people and learning how to make a typical Roman dinner menu from scratch. Meet your host in Piazza Mattei, a fascinating square in the heart of Rome's former Jewish Ghetto. The area offers breathtaking views of the stratification of Rome over centuries and a number of shops as well as very good restaurants selling Jewish-Roman food. Enjoy the easygoing lifestyle the Ghetto is so famous for! Access the restaurant where the class takes place and meet your Chef who will be ready to share his recipes with you and reveal his tricks. This is a hands-on class, but being a simple spectator is also an option: you can relax, watch the chef at work, while you sip a glass of wine. You will learn how to make homemade pasta from scratch, cleaning and preparing seasonal vegetables to fry, and taste desserts that Roman grandmothers used to cook for their kids. Seasonal food is a must in Rome. In a winter class, you'll have the opportunity to learn how to peel artichokes and cook them in the Jewish style, one of the highlights of Roman cuisine (carciofi alla giudia). 



Tivoli and its villas

A few kilometers away from Rome, there's a world-renowned town, hosting two UNESCO world heritage sites: Tivoli. It's here that, back in the 2nd century AD, the emperor Hadrian built his majestic villa: a luxury country residence where he used to retreat and where he lived his late years. The huge complex includes more than 30 buildings, several swimming pools, former thermal stations and covers an area that's larger than a square kilometer, which gives quite an idea of this place's aim: to show the greatness, opulence and vast power of the emperor. In the 16th century, much of the remaining marble and statues were removed from Hadrian's Villa by Cardinal Ippolito II d'Este, to decorate his own villa located nearby: Villa d'Este, another UNESCO world heritage site. Largely frescoed on the inside, the Villa is surrounded by a unique garden, displaying a complex system of pools, water jets, channels, fountains, cascades, and water games. And what makes this system of fountains such an incredible masterpiece of engineering is that it works entirely by the force of gravity, without pumps. Leaving Rome in the morning, you'll have half a day to enjoy these architectural beauties accompanied by a professional guide, who'll provide you with an audio receiver and earphones: you won't miss a single detail! And you don't even need to wrap your head around how to reach Tivoli: you can either opt for our pick-up service from your centrally located hotel or save some dimes and reach us at our meeting point. 


Capri island and Blue Grotto

In the late afternoon, we'll sail back to Naples and, from there, we'll travel back to Rome leaving behind the unforgettable colorful island of Capri.
