



Cotee River Brewing Company

On Wednesday, April 1, 2020, Florida Governor Ron DeSantis issued Executive Order 20-91, ordering Floridians to “Stay at Home.”

This order outlines when it is appropriate for people to leave their homes, which services and activities are considered essential, and what businesses and employees are essential to the continuance of the economy and successful abolition of this threat.

Additionally, the Executive Order states that the State of Florida will abide by the list of essential businesses and services outlined by the Department of Homeland Security. In the outline, breweries are manufacturers of beverage and are classified as essential.

Food Packaging and Production:

- Food manufacturer employees and their supplier employees, including beverage production facilities.
- Workers supporting groceries, pharmacies and other retail that sells food and beverage products.

In accordance with the new order, and after consulting with the Department of Business and Professional Regulation, and with clarification and guidance from our council at the Florida Brewers Guild, we have determined that Cotee River Brewing Company will remain open on a limited basis. We will be limiting the amount of guests and staff that are in our facility at one time to help ensuring protection of those who visit us.

To protect our guests and staff, and to ensure we are adhering to all guidelines recommended by the CDC, we have enacted the following protocols, effective immediately.

- Guest are to remain a minimum of 6 feet from another guest
- Only 2 separate guests are allowed in the brewery at one time. All guests waiting are asked to form a line outside the front door and are asked to maintain 6 feet from each other.
- All growlers being returned for refill will be sanitized by brewery staff.
- Menus and counters will be sanitized after each person’s use.
- All pens and clipboards will be sanitized after each person’s use.

*Additionally, Cotee River Brewing Staff and owners will do whatever is necessary to ensure the safety of guests and staff, as directed, during this time.
