This course is designed for students who used to have a CDL or years of work experience operating a tractor-trailer. A student must be able to perform safely and adequately all backing and driving maneuvers to qualify for this course. It is a refresher training that focuses mainly on pre-trip in preparation for successfully completing the commercial driver's license exam.
