CHECK-IN PROCEDURES

- All staff staying at camp will be required to be present on UWYCC campus prior to 3pm to assist with camper check-in and registration.
- There will be a designated check-in area at the beginning of the campus.
- Drop-off will be as follows:
 - Campers whose last name begins with A-L: 3p-4p
 - Campers whose last name begins M-Z: 4p-5p
- Once check-in has occurred and the camp secretary has gained all forms and donation, the camper will be notified of his/her cabin number and counselor(s). The camper will then be escorted by a staff member to his/her cabin, with the accompaniment of one parent/guardian. The parent/guardian can assist with placing items in the cabin and then will be required to leave.
