UWYCC RULES AND REGULATIONS

- No camper will be permitted to leave the campground without written pre-approval by the camp manager. Campers may not operate a vehicle on campgrounds.
- 2. Conduct and speech exhibited at camp must be in keeping with Christian principles.
- 3. The use of alcohol/drugs/tobacco products of any kind are strictly forbidden.
- 4. Clothing worn at camp shall be in accordance with modest Christian attire. The camp manager and staff can and will decide if the clothing is inappropriate. Campers/workers will be asked to change his/her clothes if they are deemed inappropriate.

Inappropriate items include, but are not limited to:

- Shorts/skirts/dresses shorter than 2 inches above the knee
- Anything tight enough or loose enough to expose undergarments (yoga pants, leggings, etc.)
- No spaghetti strap tops/dresses, tank tops, or belly shirts
- Clothing that is offensive or advertises alcoholic beverages, drinking establishments, tobacco, etc.
- 5. Clothing and shoes MUST always be worn outside of the cabin.
- 6. Due to our busy daily schedule and mandatory camper participation, we discourage visitation. We suggest visitation be limited to the evening service, which begins at 7:00 p.m. each night.
- 7. No cell phones, iPods, handheld games, other electronic devices allowed.
- 8. No bodily contact of any kind.
- 9. Campers are to always stay with their group.
- 10. No snacks outside the cabin (inside only if you have enough to share).
- II. No fighting, pranks, raiding of cabins, hazing or any other dangerous behavior as determined by the camp manager will be tolerated.
- 12. All camp rules will be enforced. The camp manager/camp dean has the authority to send any camper/worker/visitor home that refuses to adhere to camp rules.
