**Game Leaders in MiniRoos Age Grades**

Consistent with the Football Federation Australia MiniRoos guidelines, matches in modified football are to be officiated by a Game Leader.

Where the Game Leader is appointed via the Football Association or its Referee Branch, and there is an agreement in place that the Referee will be paid, the relevant payment applies.

The payments do not apply where a Football Association does not approve the official appointment of qualified Referees to act as Game Leaders.
