

Outback Odyssey Car Parking

If you require car parking for the duration of Outback Odyssey, please see options outlined below.

ADELAIDE

We have made arrangements with the City of Adelaide UPark facilities for access to car parking at 3 locations in Adelaide CBD. This must **be pre-booked - the cost is \$19.50 per day**. [Head to our bookings page](#) to select and confirm your carpark booking.

Adelaide (Full Mawson) 16 Days Sat-Sun: \$312AUD

(in on Saturday morning 3 May, out on Sunday evening 18 May = 16 days)

Adelaide (Full Mawson) 17 Days Fri-Sun: \$331.50AUD

(in on Friday afternoon 2 May, out on Sunday evening 18 May = 17 days)

Adelaide (Full Mawson) 17 Days Sat-Mon: \$331.50AUD

(in on Saturday morning 3 May, out on Monday morning 19 May = 17 days)

Adelaide (Full Mawson) 18 Days Fri-Mon: \$351AUD

(in on Friday afternoon 2 May, out on Monday morning 19 May = 18 days)

Adelaide (Leg #1) 5 Days: \$97.50AUD

(in on Saturday morning 3 May, out on Wednesday evening 7 May = 5 days)

Adelaide (Leg #1 + #2) 11 Days: \$214.50AUD

Location options

Option 1: [UPark Grote Street](#) premises, 82 Grote St Adelaide, situated above the Adelaide Central Bus Station. **Note: there is a 2.1m vehicle height limit.**

This facility is also where the Outback Odyssey transfer bus will arrive on Sunday 18 May. Your tour luggage will be available for collection from inside the Adelaide Central Bus Station when you arrive back in Adelaide.

Option 2: [UPark Pirie Flinders](#) premises at 191-207 Pirie St (access via Sudholz Pl) – **height limit of 2.2m.**

This facility is also nearby to where the Outback Odyssey will start at Hindmarsh Square on Saturday 3 May.

Both of the above parking facilities are a multi-story park with monitored security. Access is available between 6am and midnight.

Option 3: For those with over-height vehicles, there is also the open air / outdoors [UPark Andrew Street](#) premises, 2 Andrew Street Adelaide, adjacent to the UPark Grote Street premises.

There is no height limit at this facility and it is unfenced and open to public access.

Regardless of which facility you park in, you will need to check in at the Bike SA office (Friday) or at registration on Saturday morning first to collect your discounted parking ticket and directions to the parking facility.

Option 4: For those who require parking for other oversized vehicles, caravans, camper trailers, etc, we suggest that you contact [Andrews Airport Parking](#), located in Bowden, approx 5km from the centre of Adelaide. Ph: (08) 8340 5200

BURRA

Free parking (booking required: [head to our bookings page](#)) is available at the Department of Environment and Heritage depot, Landore Street, Burra. The DEH depot gate is locked overnight and when unattended.

Check-in at Burra Oval first to get settled in prior to parking. The depot will be open for the parking of vehicles between 3pm and 4pm Wed 7 May; then again at approximately 10.30am on Mon 12 May and 2.30pm on Sun 18 May (or whenever the transfer vehicle arrives from Melrose / Blinman).

Burra (Leg #2) 6 Days: Free

(in on Wednesday 7 May 3-4pm, out on Monday 12 May 10.30am = 6 days)

Burra (Legs #2 + #3) 11 Days: Free

(in on Wednesday 7 May 3-4pm, out on Sunday 18 May 2.30pm = 11 days)

MELROSE

Free unsecured public parking (booking required) is available behind the District Council of Mount Remarkable offices. This location is in the centre of town, close to the Melrose Institute, where we will be having our meals. If leaving your car at Melrose, you can first drive your vehicle to the campsite to unload your gear.

Melrose (Leg #3) 7 Days: Free
