Dear Annual Tour rider

Thank you for booking your bus transfers from Adelaide to Cape Jervis on Saturday 19th October, and return from Cape Jervis to Adelaide on Saturday 26 October.

Please note the times below, and make sure that you arrive in plenty of time to load your luggage and bikes. You will need to remove your pedals and turn your handlebars sideways to facilitate loading and transport. If possible, please do this before you arrive at check-in to save time when loading. If necessary, there will be tools available to assist at check-in. Panniers and handlebar bags plus any lights, bike computers, etc. should also be removed for transport. Bikes will be loaded (wrapped in packing blankets) on to the semi-trailer and baggage will be loaded on to the luggage truck. Reminder to check your baggage allowance. The bus will be DEPARTING PROMPTLY at 8.30am sharp – and will not wait for latecomers!

Friday 18TH October – If you wish to load your **luggage only** onto the luggage truck on Friday – this will be available from 3pm – 5pm only at our office address (11a Croydon Road, Keswick). Make sure that you have all you need for overnight and to travel on the bus/ferry packed into a separate bag to take with you. Note: we cannot accept bikes for overnight storage / transport on Friday. These should be taken directly to the bus terminal on Saturday morning for loading.

SATURDAY 19 OCTOBER- COACH TRANSFER ADELAIDE TO CAPE JERVIS – CHECK IN 7.30AM

- **LUGGAGE LOADING 7.30AM – 8.15AM**
- **DEPART PROMPTLY 8.30AM - ARRIVE 10.30AM**

Please note it is unlikely that you will be able to find a coffee or food at that time, so make sure you have eaten breakfast at your accommodation. There are vending machines available in the bus station, with snacks and cold drinks. Please make sure that you have suitable comfortable/warm attire for the bus trip and ferry crossing. The bus trip will be 2 hours travel time.

You will NOT be able to access your luggage until the truck arrives at our first overnight destination in Penneshaw. Lunch will be served at the Dudley United Football Club onsite from 1pm.

SATURDAY 26 OCTOBER – COACH TRANSFER CAPE JERVIS TO ADELAIDE

- **PASSENGER LOADING 3.15PM – 3.30PM**
- **DEPART PROMPTLY 3.45PM - ARRIVE 5.45PM**

On Saturday 26 October, you will be riding from Kingscote to Penneshaw, a distance of 60 kilometres. When you leave Kingscote you will be asked to load your baggage onto the luggage truck first as it will stay on the truck until Adelaide. When you arrive at Penneshaw, you will need to take your bike (with pedals and handlebars turned sideways) to the semi trailer for loading - for the journey back to Adelaide. Bikes will be “wrapped” in packing blankets to protect them in transit.

Before leaving Kingscote, you should pack a small bag of your essential needs not only for the ferry trip but also the coach trip, as you won't be able to access your luggage again until you get back to Adelaide. This small bag will travel in a separate vehicle, and will be available for you to collect in Penneshaw.

Lunch will be served at the football club in Penneshaw from 11.30am, and then you will need to allow yourself 10 minute walk to get to the ferry terminal, and ready to board at 2pm for the 2.30pm departure.

The bus will be loading at Cape Jervis from 3.15pm for the 3.45pm departure time and will return to Adelaide at 5.45pm to the Adelaide Central Bus Station.
