Dear Annual Tour rider,

Please find details below regarding carparking options for the Annual Tour (if required).

Our overnight camping venue for the start and finish of Annual Tour will be the South Gambier Football Club at the Blue Lake Sports Park complex.

We have made arrangements with the South Gambier Football Club to park cars at the oval precinct for the duration of Annual Tour. This must **be pre-booked and the cost is \$80/vehicle for the whole period.**

**Please contact the BikeSA office ASAP to confirm and pay for your carpark booking.**

There is sufficient room for parking larger vehicles and those who are travelling with camper tailers/caravans. There is no additional cost for trailers/caravans.

**Car parking at this facility will be available between Saturday 14 October and Sunday 22 October only.** Early arrivals into Mount Gambier and those who wish to stay longer will need to make arrangements to camp/park elsewhere.

Please note that whilst this facility is open to public access during the day, the area is considered to be generally safe and the gates will be locked overnight. In addition, arrangements will be made for security patrols to visit the area several times each night.
