

Dirty Weekend Schools Challenge Perpetual Trophy

12hr and 6hr Mountain Bike Challenge

Keen to get out and test your endurance on the pedals?!

Here's a chance to get together with school mates and riding buddies for a fun weekend of mountain bike madness and mayhem and bring home bragging rights to your school with the Dirty Weekend Schools Challenge Perpetual Trophy - sponsored by Head for the Hills Cycling.

Who can enter?

Grab your mates and enter a team in the **Youth Team of 4**** category in either the **12hr** or **6hr** event. List the name of your school when registering for the event.

Teams may consist of a minimum of 2 and a maximum of 4 riders.

**Youth category is for riders aged 13-17yrs. A non-competing responsible adult must be in attendance at the event at all times. (Riders aged under 13yrs may be permitted only with proven mountain biking experience and prior approval of Event Manager)

Get your parents and/or teachers on board too. They can participate in any Adult category in either the **12hr** or **6hr** event as well and should list the name of your school when registering for the event.



How does it work?

The aim of the Schools Challenge is to encourage participation. Points will be awarded for both rider participation and final category placings as follows:

1 point per rider entry plus additional points for podium positions:

1st place team = 3 points per rider

2nd place team = 2 points per rider

3rd place team = 1 point per rider

The School with the highest number of accumulated points at finish of the event will be awarded the Dirty Weekend Schools Challenge Trophy.

The more entries per school increases the chance of your school winning the Dirty Weekend Schools Challenge trophy even if your team doesn't win the Youth Team of 4 event.

Want to ride with your mates but you go to different schools?? No problem!

Each team may consist of riders representing different schools. You just need to indicate the name of your school when you register.

In addition to having the chance to bring home the Dirty Weekend Schools Challenge Perpetual Trophy (which your school gets to keep until next year's event) your team will also been in the running to win a mountain bike skills coaching session for your school courtesy of Head for the Hills Cycling.
