A Candle in the Wind (Part One)

Many of you probably remember the song entitled, "A Candle in the Wind." I am not endorsing all the lyrics in the song, but during the course of the song it has the following words, "...you lived your life like a candle in the wind; never knowing who to cling to when the rain set in...." The point of the song was Marilyn Monroe had allowed bad people to influence her life.

Jesus said, "Ye are the salt of the earth: but if the salt have lost his savour, wherewith shall it be salted? it is thenceforth good for nothing, but to be cast out, and to be trodden under foot of men. Ye are the light of the world. A city that is set on an hill cannot be hid. Neither do men light a candle, and put it under a bushel, but on a candlestick; and it giveth light unto all that are in the house. Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven" (Mat. 5:13-16). Notice carefully that Jesus said that Christians are the light of the world. We all have probably heard a discussion of the various meanings of the Greek words Jesus used in the text. The word "light" used in verse fourteen to describe the life of the Christian is a word that carries the idea of reflection. In other words, Christians do not have a light source from within, but their light is reflective. We are to reflect by our lives the light of Jesus Christ. Paul wrote, "Be ye followers of me, even as I also am of Christ" (1 Cor. 11:1). Paul also wrote, "I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ liveth in me: and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by the faith of the Son of God, who loved me, and gave himself for me" (Gal. 2:20). Of course, the idea is again that we are to reflect the light of Jesus by our lives. John wrote, concerning Jesus, "In him was life; and the life was the light of men. And the light shineth in darkness; and the darkness comprehended it not" (John 1:4-5).

Jesus described the Christian life as light in this world of darkness. People of the world should recognize a Christian by his manner of speech, by the exemplary life that he lives, and by the fact that he willing to teach the lost the Gospel of Christ.
