JESUS HEALS THE WIDOW'S SON Luke 17:11-17

INTRODUCTION:

- 1. We are continuing our study of our favorite childhood Bible stories.
- 2. Jesus had just healed the Centurion's servant.
- 3. The day following, He was traveling through the country and comes to the city of Nain, which is a small village at the foot of Mount Tabor. As Jesus comes to the city, He encounters a funeral procession.
- 4. A young man had died, and he was the only son of a widow.
- 5. Jesus sees the widow weeping and has compassion on her.
- 6. He touches the bier and commands the young man to arise.
- 7. The young man immediately revives, and Jesus' fame continues to grow.

DISCUSSION:

- 1. FIRST, WE SEE DEATH (vs 11-12).
 - The people on this day are standing at the confluence of two great rivers – the river of death and the river of life (Jesus).
 - 2. Hebrews 9:27.

2. SECONDLY, WE SEE WEEPING.

- 1. God has promised us that when we reach heaven there will be no more crying, death or sorrow (Revelation 21:4).
- 2. But we know here on earth we have all the above and more.
- 3. Again, here we have the river of weeping and the river of joy!

3. THIRDLY, WE SEE THE RESURRECTION.

- 1. Obviously, Jesus is demonstrating He has power over death.
- 2. Acts 2:24.
- 3. 1 Corinthians 15:13-58.
