Zechariah 13 There is a Fountain Filled with Blood

INTRODUCTION:

- 1. Last week we noted that Zechariah prophesied that some in Israel would look upon the One Who they pierced in derision, while others would look with a spirit of mourning.
- 2. To those who looked upon the Messiah in the right way, God promised to pour out a spirit of grace and supplication (12:10).
- 3. In Chapter 13, Zechariah continues the theme "in that day."
- 4. He says that three things would happen in that day: 1) the Savior would be pierced, 2) a fountain for sin would be opened, and 3) the Shepherd would be smitten.

DISCUSSION:

- 1. The Fountain Opened (vs. 1-6)
 - 1. When God poured out His Spirit of grace and supplication by the One Who was pierced, those who mourned for Him as an Only Son would be blessed (Chapter 12).
 - 2. In that day a fountain for sin and uncleanness would be opened for God's people who were the faithful remnant.
 - 3. God would then, through the sacrifice of His Son, cause the idols to pass from the land. Not only the idols, but the prophets would also pass from the land. As the Hebrews' writer so eloquently stated, God is now speaking through His Son (Hebrews 1:1-2).
 - 4. If any continued to prophesy, they would be cut off from the land.
 - 5. When asked Who was going to accomplish this, Zechariah says the One would respond that He suffered these wounds in the house of His friends!

2. The Shepherd Smitten (7-9)

- 1. Notice carefully the sword would be used against God's Shepherd Jesus (John 10:14-16). He would turn His attention to the little ones (Luke 12:31-32).
- 2. In verse 8, Zechariah prophesies the majority would reject their King.
- 3. The remnant (1/3) would be tested by fire and yet they would continue to call upon God's Name (see 2 Corinthians 6:14-18).
