(Matthew 3:1-12)

INTRODUCTION:

- 1. First, we need to be reminded what a winnowing fan or fork is and how it was used.
- 2. It was a tool used after harvesting grain to separate the grain from the lighter particles of chaff, dirt, etc., especially by throwing it into the air and allowing the wind to blow away impurities.
- 3. John the Baptist used this to illustrate the work that Jesus would do in judging the world.
- 4. In our lesson this morning, we want to notice how God's winnowing fan removes the chaff, dirt and other impurities from our lives.
- 5. We understand that God uses His Word as a winnowing fan.
