The Sinner's Part in Salvation

Acts 2:36-41

INTRODUCTION:

- 1. Salvation is a complex, yet simple idea to understand.
- It is complex in understanding the deep love of the Father; the almost unbelievable gift of His Son, Jesus; and the undeniable revelation of the Holy Spirit of God.
- 3. Yet, salvation is also simple (2 Cor. 11:3).

DISCUSSION:

- 1. What do the Scriptures Say? (Romans 4:3).
 - 1. Acts 2:40 and Phil. 2:12
 - 2. The source of our salvation is obviously God. While God is the source and the Supreme agency of salvation; man's part is merely instrumental and subordinate.
 - 3. The salvation spoken of in these verses is salvation from sin.
- 2. The Twofold Aspect of Salvation (Acts 27:9-44).
 - 1. In this narrative, we see two aspects of salvation.
 - 2. God's deliverance was provided (v. 24).
 - 3. But men also bore responsibility (vs. 42-44).
 - 4. These same principles can be seen in our salvation from sin
- 3. The Way the Apostles Preached Salvation (Acts 2:36-41).
 - 1. They preached that there were FACTS that needed to be understood.
 - 2. There were COMMANDMENTS which needed to be obeyed.
 - 3. There were PROMISES made that only God could fulfill.
