ELISHA AND THE SHE-BEARS 2 Kings 2:23-25

INTRODUCTION:

- 1. This Bible story is a concerning to some, due to an unfortunate translation.
- The King James Version reads, "...And there came forth two she bears out of the wood, and tare forty and two children of them" (2 Kings 2:24).
- 3. The word translated children is used in the Bible to describe men as old forty-one years old (1 Kings 12:1-11). We know this because Rehoboam was forty-one when he began to reign, and he had consulted the "young men" he had grown up with!

DISCUSSION:

1. BACKGROUND:

- 1. God had just taken Elijah up into heaven by a whirlwind (2 Kings 2:1-11).
- 2. Before he ascended Elijah (his name means God, Jehovah) asked Elisha (his name means God of supplication) if there was anything he wanted before he ascended; Elisha answered he wanted a double portion of your spirit upon him. God granted that desire (2 Kings 2:12-22).

2. THE TEXT: (2 Kings 2:23-25):

- 1. Elisha goes to Beth-el (house of God).
- 2. Beth-el was formally known as Luz, but when Jacob saw the vision of a ladder ascending to heaven, the name was changed to Beth-el (Genesis 28:11-19).
- 3. During the reign of Jeroboam Beth-el became the seat of idolatrous worship (1 Kings 12:32).
- 4. As Elisha passes through Beth-el a group of ruffians (most likely teenage boys), taunt him saying, "Go up, bald head; go up thou bald head" (v 23).
- The phrase "bald head" may have a deeper meaning than just a lack of hair; it may imply empty headed (Matthew 5:21, Raca). The statement to "go up" may mean to ascend to the high places to worship an idol.
- 6. Finally, did the she-bears kill the boys or simply maul them without killing them? We cannot say with certainty!
