Faith (Heb. 11:6)

Introduction:

- Read Luke 18:1-8. How this widow and God's people are so much alike and yet in some ways so different. In many ways God and this judge are alike; yet so different.
- 2. Will Jesus find "<u>faith</u>?" What kind of "faith?" The kind that relies upon God to take care of his people. The kind that entails God's aid and assistance.
- 3. Look at 1 Thess. 5:17, Eph. 6:17, 18, Luke 22:40.
- 4. There will not be faith on the <u>earth</u> unless we do our part (Mat. 28:18-20).
- 5. Faith is important: Heb. 11:6, 2 Cor. 5:7.
- 6. We better know what it is!

Discussion:

What is Faith?

- 1. It is not the same as opinion.
- 2. Gen. 22:1-3; Heb. 11:17-19.
- 3. What about what you believe? Is it merely your opinion, or is it what God has spoken?
- 4. The Christian religion is not just a matter of opinion! It is a matter of believing what God has said (Heb. 6:18).
- 5. Heb. 11:1.

2. How Does Someone Get Faith?

- 1. Doesn't do us any good it we know what faith is, and yet we don't know how to obtain it.
- 2. Some feel that God will <u>zap</u> them with faith. God gives us faith and knowledge the same way he gives our daily bread (Mat. 6:11).
- 3. We have to hear, study, and learn about God's word, in order to get it!
- 4. Is it merely my opinion? NO (Rom. 10:17; John 17:20; 20:31; and Acts 14:1).
- 5. The devil know what some people refuse to believe and that is that it takes the Bible to produce faith (Luke 8:12).

3. What Does Faith Do For Us?

- 1. Rom. 5:1; James 2:24; and Acts 15:9.
- 2. Must be obedient (James 2 and Rom. 16:25).
- 3. Don't you want to have that kind of faith?
