THE PARABLE OF THE TEN VIRGINS – BE READY Matthew 25:1-13

INTRODUCTION:

- 1. Review the context of the parable
- 2. This parable divides itself into four parts, naturally.
 - 1. Be Ready;
 - 2. Participate;
 - 3. Don't Be Excluded; and
 - 4. Pronouncement.

DISCUSSION:

- 1. BE READY (25:1-10).
 - 1. Wisdom is essential. Five virgins took lamps and oil. They were prepared foresight.
 - 2. It is foolish not to prepare for future events.
 - 3. Are you Ready?
 - 4. There is NO repentance after death.

2. THE PARTICIPATION (v 10).

- 1. It really is simple.
- 2. Those who prepare go to heaven.
- 3. Those that are not prepared will not go to heaven.

3. THE EXCLUSION (vs 11-12).

- 1. These young women were lost because they were unprepared. They even cried out "Lord, Lord" (Matthew 7:21). They asked for Jesus to open the door. Did they have this right? Yes, because they were part of the original parade.
- 2. It is sad because this did not have to happen!
- 3. Being unprepared is inexcusable.

4. THE PRONOUNCEMENT (v 13).

- 1. Jesus was making this point with this parable.
- 2. Watch!
- 3. Be ready!
