Zechariah 14:1-21

INTRODUCTION:

- 1. This chapter has been known as one of the most difficult chapters in the entire Bible.
- 2. Martin Luther said, "Here, in this chapter, I give up. For I am not sure what the prophet is talking about."
- 3. Our own brethren often disagree about the meaning of this chapter.
- 4. I will readily admit that I will be unable to satisfy everyone concerning this chapter, but I will try.
- 5. We must recognize that this chapter is a continuation of the book!

DISCUSSION:

1. Judgment on Jerusalem (vs. 1-2).

- 1. One can hardly read these verses and not think of the words of Jesus in Luke 21:20, "...when ye shall see Jerusalem compassed with armies...."
- 2. Zechariah uses the phase "in that day" at least 20 times in this book. He does so in chapters 12 and 13 in speaking of events surrounding the life of Jesus eight times. These references speak of events about the ministry of Christ. He uses the phrase six times in chapter 14. For all those who want to place this prophecy out in our future fail to acknowledge this essential phrase!

2. Judgment on the Nations (Rome) (vs. 3-8).

- 1. The Lord will fight (v. 3).
- 2. Jesus will stand on the Mount of Olives (v. 4).
- 3. Then Living Waters will prevail (v. 8). This is clearly a reference to Jesus providing the water of Life (John 4).

3. The Kingdom of the Lord (vs. 9-21).

- 1. Jesus will then rule over all the earth (vs. 9-11).
- 2. God will send plagues against the enemies of God's people (vs. 12-15).
- 3. Either repent or suffer the consequences (vs. 16-19).
- 4. HOLINESS UNTO THE LORD (vs. 20-21).
