DAILY BIBLE READING

The apostle Paul wrote, "Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth" (2 Tim. 2:15). One of the things that we have often stressed is the need for a daily regimen of studying the Bible. As another new year rapidly approaches—wow—it is almost 2023; we are again stressing the need to study the Word of God. Before we go any further, I would like to take a moment and commend those who have been so diligent in their studies this year. It seemed to be a fairly common practice in years gone by for congregations to ask for a show of hands for everyone who had been a daily Bible reader was last week. This seems to be out of vogue today!

The apostle Paul wrote, "But continue thou in the things which thou hast learned and hast been assured of, knowing of whom thou hast learned them; And that from a child thou hast known the holy scriptures, which are able to make thee wise unto salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus. All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness: That the man of God may be perfect, throughly furnished unto all good works" (2 Tim. 3:14-17). Several words literally jump out of what Paul has written. The first word—continue—indicates something that we are to keep on doing. The next words—holy scriptures—what we are to continue in. Paul then lists four things the Bible will accomplish. We obviously need to be diligent in studying the Scriptures. Jesus said we should search the Scriptures because they contain eternal life (John 5:39).

One of the joys of living today is we have so many resources available to help us study the Scriptures. Please as we begin to consider making plans for 2023, let's make sure Bible Study is at the top of the list. By the way, there are many schedules you can find on the internet that gives a list for Daily Bible Reading. As always, we caution to be on guard for false teachings sometimes associated with various websites.
