What Does Christ Mean to You?

To many people Jesus means many different things. To some He means absolutely nothing. He is never acknowledged in anything they do. To others He means very little. He might be acknowledged at certain times of the year: Christmas, Easter, etc. To some, even though the number seems small, He is everything. We sing a song, "He is My Everything." The lyrics of the song mention that Jesus is everything anyone could need. In our article, let's examine some of the things the Bible teaches that Jesus is.

- 1). Jesus is the fulfillment of prophecy. The Bible says, "...Behold, a virgin shall conceive, and bear a son, and shall call his name Immanuel" (Isa. 7:14). Thus, Jesus is the ultimate fulfillment of the prophecies of the Old Testament.
- 2). Jesus is the Son of God. Listen to God the Father, Himself, "...This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased; hear ye him" (Mat. 17:5).
- 3). Jesus is the Savior of the world. "And we have seen and do testify that the Father sent the Son to be the Saviour of the world" (1 John 4:14). One of the saddest facts is that Jesus is the Savior of the world, but most do not recognize Him.
- 4). Jesus is the Sacrifice for our sins. "But this man, after he had offered one sacrifice for sins for ever, sat down on the right hand of God" (Heb. 9:12).
- 5). Jesus is the Exalted One. "Wherefore God also hath highly exalted him, and given him a name which is above every name" (Phil. 2:9).
- 6.) Jesus is the mediator between God and man. "For there is one God, and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus" (1 Tim. 2:5).
- 7). Jesus is the Head of the church. "And hath put all things under his feet, and gave him to be the head over all things to the church, Which is his body, the fullness of him that filleth all in all" (Eph. 1:22,23).
- 8). Jesus is King of kings and Lord of lords. "Which in his times he shall shew, who is the blessed and only Potentate, the King of kings, and Lord of lords; Who only hath immortality, dwelling in the light which no man can approach unto; whom no man hath seen, nor can see: to whom be honour and power everlasting. Amen" (1 Tim. 6:15-16).

There are many other things that we could mention about Jesus, but let's all do our best to remember what Christ should mean to everyone.
