CHRISTIANITY 101: CHURCH ORGANIZATION

(Acts 14:23)

INTRODUCTION:

- 1. The Lord has organized His church in the simplest conceivable way, yet the strongest, and most durable way.
- 2. Sadly, many have been tampering with the organization of the church.
- 3. Each congregation must be following the divine pattern found in the Bible.

1. CONGREGATIONAL AUTHORITY.

- 1. The Supreme Ruler over His Church (Colossians 1:18).
 - 1. He has never relinquished His headship to anyone.
 - 2. He has never surrendered His authority to anyone.
- 2. The Lord's church is therefore a theocracy.
 - 1. Christ is our law giver (James 4:12). He holds legislative function.
 - 2. Christ is our king (Rev. 19:16). This is His executive function.
 - 3. Christ is our judge (John 5:22). This is His judicial function.
- 3. The churches of Christ have no earthly headquarters. The headquarters is in heaven where the Head of the church is (Col. 3:1).

2. CONGREGATIONAL AUTONOMY.

- 1. Autonomy is defined as: "Independent in government, self-governing"; "the right to attend to your own business."
- 2. Each local congregation has the right under God to decide what expediencies she will employ in executing God's law.
- 3. Each local congregation is at liberty to function in harmony with the King's law in reference to everything the law authorizes it to do.

3. CONGREGATIONAL ORGANIZATION.

- 1. The church is spoken of in two senses in the New Testament: UNIVERSALLY and LOCALLY.
 - 1. Universally, the church of our Lord has no earthly organization.
 - 2. Locally, the Lord has organized his church. Christ has delegated authority in the local congregation to the elders.
 - 1). There is a plurality of elders in every congregation (Acts14:23).
 - 2). The elders lead, guide, oversee, rule and direct, and all the members are in subjection to them.
 - 3). The church of Christ also has a special group of men called deacons (1 Timothy 3:8-13).
 - 4). Preachers, teachers, etc. are under the authority of the elders (Hebrews 13:7, 17).
