#### **CHRISTIANITY 101: PRAYING**

#### **INTRODUCTION:**

- 1. 1 Timothy 2:1-6.
- 2. Luke 11:1.
- 3. In Luke 11:1, Jesus' disciples asked Him to teach them to pray. We need this same teaching today.

#### **DISCUSSION:**

#### 1. WHAT IS PRAYER?

- 1. The word translated from the Greek language means "to pray to God, that is, supplicate, worship."
- 2. 1 Samuel 1:15, Hannah "poured out my soul before the LORD."
- 3. In 1 Timothy 2:1, Paul uses the words, supplications (a petition), prayers (to supplicate to God), intercessions (to pray in someone else's behalf) and giving of thanks (showing gratitude to God for what He has done for us).

#### 2. LORD TEACH US TO PRAY.

- 1. Jesus taught us to address our prayers to the Father (Luke 11:2). The Father's name is to be held in reverence.
- 2. "In the name of Jesus" (John 16:23-24). This means by His authority. Jesus told His disciples "And in that day ye shall ask me nothing..." (John 16:23), telling us that once Jesus ascended back to the Father, we were to address our prayers to the Father (John 16:23).

#### 3. EXAMPLES OF PRAYERS IN THE FIRST CENTURY CHURCH.

- 1. They lifted their voices together to God... (Acts 4:23-24).
- 2. My heart's desire and prayer to God... (Romans 10:1).
- 3. But we pray to God... (2 Corinthians 13:7).
- 4. For this reason I bow my knees before the Father... (Ephesians 3:14).
- 5. We always thank God, the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, when we pray for you (Colossians 1:3).
- 6. I pray God... (1 Thessalonians 5:23).
