THE LIFE OF MOSES

- 1. Moses' (drawn out of the water) life can be divided into three parts of 40 years each.
- 2. Moses' life begins as a slave in Egypt. He spends the first 40 years being raised in Pharaoh's house.
- 3. After killing an Egyptian for abusing a fellow Hebrew, Moses flees to Midian where he marries Zipporah (her name means Bird and refers to a small, hopping bird) and has two sons, Gershom (whose name means I have been a stranger in a strange land), and Eliezer (whose name means the God of my father has delivered me from the sword of Pharaoh).
- 4. Moses then spends 40 years leading Israel in the wilderness. **DISCUSSION:**

1. MOSES IN EGYPT.

- 1. Moses' parents are Amram and Jochebed. His brother is Aaron, and his sister is Miriam.
- 2. Moses is born under the curse of Egypt; every male child is to be cast into the river (Exodus 1:22). Technically, Amram and Jochebed obeyed Pharaoh, but with a twist (Acts 7:21)!
- 3. Moses, remember drawn out of the water, is raised by Pharaoh's daughter in the very house of Pharaoh (Acts 7:21-22).
- 4. Moses flees to Midian (Acts 7:23-29).

2. MOSES IN MIDIAN.

- 1. Moses spent the next 40 years in obscurity (Acts 7:29-30).
- 2. This is where he marries Zipporah, the daughter of Jethro (Exodus 3:1-22).
- 3. It is during this time his sons are born.

3. MOSES LEADING ISRAEL.

- 1. God called Moses not only to be the leader of His people, but also to be His prophet, and His lawgiver.
- 2. Acts 7:30-53.
